

# AP Statistics – Final Project

## Overview

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You made it to the final project! Congratulations on completing your final exam (and possibly the AP exam, too!). This project will be worth 12.5% of your grade this semester and is weighted equally with your final exam.

For this project, you will be paired up with one or two other students. You and your partner(s) will either complete an observational study or conduct an experiment. You will be working on this project over the next several class periods, and will have to collect data both during and outside of class. The final products will be a poster and a video presentation. The poster will include a detailed description of your design, your data, your conclusions, and your reflection of how it all turned out. Your video will require a presentation of what you put on your poster. We are doing a video INSTEAD of an in-class presentation, but the information must all still be there.

On the day that your project is due, we will complete a Gallery Walk. Your poster, along with the posters of your classmates, will be hung up around the classroom. They will each have a link to your video presentation (QR code). You will be randomly assigned to 3 posters in the room. You will look at those posters while watching the video presentation on your smart device or chrome book (please bring headphones!). After you have watched the presentation, you will give feedback via a link in the description of the video presentation.
